Please note the following information:

- If you have any other questions about writing a codicil or updating your will you should seek advice from your solicitor.
- The codicil must be signed by two independent witnesses (one in Scotland) who are not your Executor or your Executors spouse, a beneficiary of your will or codicil, or a beneficiary's spouse. They must both be present when you sign the codicil.
- The codicil must be kept with the existing will but not attached to it.
